The name “Clone 337” is full of mystery. What exactly do those numbers mean? To vintners, 337 foretells an early ripening Cabernet Sauvignon, ideal for cooler sites. 337 is often the first Cabernet Sauvignon block we harvest, creating an “Old World” Cabernet Sauvignon that is lighter on its feet, and perfect for the spring. This block also contains our estate’s oldest vines.

100% of the grapes were estate grown. The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard is matched by Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking.

### TASTING NOTE

Aromas of strawberry rhubarb, toasted almond and tobacco leaf lead into a palate exemplifies a delicate marriage of barrel and fruit tannins. The 2021’s nuanced tannic character and pie cherry notes add complexity to this full bodied, brightly acidic wine, which will continue to cellar beautifully through 2034.

# CLONE 337 CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2020

### TASTING NOTE

This early-ripening clone coming from our Crown Block vineyards always appears slightly lighter in color than our other Clone 30 driven Cabs. But because we can harvest this fruit weeks before other Cabernets, the tannins on these wines need more time to settle. Brandied cherries and boysenberry work in conjunction with baking spices, dried florals, and fennel, and even a cool Rhubarb Pie quality. Fruit on the palate settles rather quickly, and you are left with the subtle braise of fine-grain tannins, espressos grounds, baking spice, and vanilla. Decant before opening; will drink its best in 5-6 years.
