This is a 100% single vineyard, estate grown wine from the Triska Vineyard. This is one of the northernmost site in the acclaimed Crane Ridge micro-region: it faces north, experiences constant breezes, and lies under a thick blanket of coastal fog each morning. The site is so cool, the Triskas planted a hazelnut orchard to the side!

Darcie and her family believe in creating a perfect match between terroir and varietal. Working side by side with their neighbors Mark and Maria Triska, Darcie and her family planted the site with Pinot Noir. This pioneering vineyard has earned accolades from Wine Spectator and Wine Enthusiast. The purity of the fruit is complemented by a sensitive French oak maturation.

tasting note

Cranberry, and raspberry, silky tannins, gentle oak nuances and a long, tapioca pudding finish.
